Panhellenic Academic Status Definitions: Honor Roll is .15 or more above the AUWA. Good Standing is above the AUFA. Probation is applied for below the AUWA. Chapters on probation must submit an Academic Improvement Plan to the Panhellenic Scholarship Director for approval by the end of the third week of the semester. Chapters with a second consecutive semester on probation cannot submit proposals for fraternity philanthropy tournaments. Chapters with a third consecutive semester on probation cannot submit proposals for fraternity philanthropy tournaments nor participate in sorority philanthropy tournaments sponsored by IFC fraternities.

**Grades changes may be submitted with documentation from the Office of the Registrar by September 13, 2007.
(Roster changes are not accepted after May 17, 2007 for the purpose of grade point calculations.)**
