Illegally Download: End Up in Court

San Diego State University requires all users of our computer and network facilities to comply with federal and state laws related to these services, including those that protect copyrights. The appropriate policies for students can be found at <http://rezcon.sdsu.edu/AUP.html>

A number of organizations, and companies, are actively protecting their copyrighted works, including music and video. They have the capability to trace alleged infringements of those copyrights to individual network addresses. As you may know, they have initiated legal action against individuals they believe have violated these copyrights across the country. The potential impact upon violators can be significant, in some cases exceeding hundreds of thousands of dollars.

If an organization traces a potential violation to a network address managed by SDSU they may notify us. We will take action as detailed in the Acceptable Use Policies of our university. In some cases we will forward information from these organizations to an individual that we identify as associated with a network address. We will only provide personal information associated with a particular address when served with a lawfully executed subpoena.

Do not download, or share, copyrighted information in violation of applicable laws and campus policies. Do not allow others to use your computer for activities that are not allowed under SDSU policies or various laws.
