

Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Fall-Winter, 2009-2010

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is offered on an appointment basis six days a week at San Diego State University. The exam is available to anyone, regardless of your college or present or future enrollment. Examinees may take the exam more than once at our facility and there is no minimum waiting time between attempts.

Used by nursing schools throughout the United States, the TEAS exam is multiple-choice and consists of the following sections:

Reading	50 minutes	40 questions
Mathematics	56 minutes	45 questions
Science	38 minutes	30 questions
English	65 minutes	55 questions

The location of the exam is the Office of Student Testing, Assessment and Research, Student Services West 2549 (second floor, northwest portion, of the building with the clock tower). Visitor parking is available for \$1 per hour at the Lot O, College Avenue and Lindo Paseo, northwest corner (Mapquest 5140 College Avenue, San Diego 62115). The clock tower is visible from Lot O.

To expedite the check-in process, please log onto the test publisher's web site, www.atitesting.com, and create an account. Please remember to bring your user name and password to the test. When you create your registration, you can indicate a program or institution to receive your TEAS scores. Additional score recipients can be ordered after the exam.

The regular exam schedule is daily, Mondays through Saturdays, at 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM plus 4:30 PM on Thursdays and most Saturdays. During the winter holiday periods, the TEAS will be offered on November 11 and December 31. No exams will be offered and the office will be closed on November 25-28, December 21-30, January 1-4, and January 15-18.

To be admitted to the test, the candidate must have a current government-issued identification with a photo and signature, such as a driver's license, passport, military ID, government ID, or alien residency (green) card. No food, drink, books, notes, calculators, or electronic devices are permitted in the testing room. The results will be available at the conclusion of the exam.

The cost of the exam is \$45, payable the day of the exam. Payment methods are cash, check or money order made out to "SDSU". Credit card payments are acceptable for weekday exams only.
