

Sweetwater District January 30, 2010 EPT/ELM Exam

San Diego State University is pleased to offer a special administration of the CSU English Placement Test (EPT) and Entry Level Mathematics (ELM) exam on Saturday, January 30 specifically designed for seniors in the Sweetwater Union High School District. Sweetwater students will have a separate check-in area, testing rooms, and support staff on the day of the test and the normal exam and parking fees will be waived, subject to space availability.

The English Placement Exam and the Entry Level Mathematics Exam will begin promptly at 8:30 AM in the Geology Mathematics and Computer Sciences (GMCS) Building, Room 328. Free parking will be available only in Parking Structure One (PS1) on the southeast corner of College Avenue and Alvarado Road. Park in any student, faculty, or staff space and take the elevator to the top (6th floor). Proceed across the pedestrian bridge over College Avenue and up the stairs to the campus itself. Turn right at the service road and the GMCS Building will be straight ahead on your right.

On the day of the exam, please bring your admission ticket, a photo ID with signature (preferably a valid driver's license or passport), and several number two pencils.

Advance registration is required and will be open through this web site. You can take **either** the EPT **or** the ELM **but not both** on January 30 and cannot have taken the same exam on January 16. Capacity for this special test session is limited, so it is very important to register early. Once the capacity for this exam has filled, you will not be able to sign up through this web site. Students unable to register in advance but still wishing to take the exam will be admitted as walk-ins on the morning of the test but will be charged the regular \$18 fee (cash, check or money order payable to "ETS").

To register for the exam, please go to www.sa.sdsu.edu/testofc/regpage, select "San Diego State University, EPT Only" or "San Diego State University, ELM Only" and proceed from there. Please disregard references to fees on the day of the test if you are a Sweetwater District senior.
